PAINTBALL!



We've have a nearby professional Paintball Field with multiple fields, located on 300 plus acres of land - it's huge! They have 3-Speedball Fields and 2-Wooded Fields. Another piece of good news, they have enough equipment so we can all play at the same time. All this for the same \$25.00 we charged last session. We'll take a 30-minute bus ride to the field, during which all the rules and details will be explained. All of this means, we will have more play time, more equipment, bigger and better fields to play on - what a deal! It's guaranteed to be a blast!!!

If you would like to sign up, the registration cost for the weekend will be \$120.00 instead of \$95.00. The additional \$25.00 will cover the cost of the equipment (paintball marker, 200 rounds of paint, safety goggles and the bus rental). If you own all your own equipment the cost is \$15.00 per person, making your total \$110.00, which covers the Field cost and the bus rental. Also everyone will need to buy his or her paint at the field - **no outside paint allowed**. Extra rounds can be purchased from the Paintball Shop located at the field for \$4.00 per 100 rounds.

We only have 45 spaces available! So the first 45 campers to send in their Registration Forms, completed Paintball Agreement Form and payment will be able to play. If you are under 18 years of age you must have a waiver filled out completely by your parent or legal guardian. If you do not have a completed waiver, you will unfortunately not be able to play.

| <p>The Ridge:</p> <p>Our largest field, about 12 acres, has something for every kind of player. There are dense woods on one side, thin woods in the center and wide-open space on the other side. There are also 2-story forts to keep a lookout and bridges to make it across the ravines that separate the two sides of the field. We normally play a 20-minute game here and it takes all of that to make it to the opponents fort and back!</p> | <p>Speedball:</p> <p>This field is about the size of a football field with the flag on an island that is surrounded by a moat! Bridges give both teams access to the island, but it's lonely on that island when everybody on the other team is aiming at you! Numbered bunkers with slots to aim out of and tire forts make up the rest of the speedball field. This is a fast 10-minute game for fleet footed runners and quick thinkers!</p> |
| <p>The Woods:</p> <p>Dense woods and lots of forts make up this field, which is a little bigger than a football field. It's hard to sneak around on this field due to all the leaves and twigs, but there are plenty of bunkers to move forward towards the opponents flag. This is normally a 12- minute game.</p> | <p>The Spool:</p> <p>A 210' x 150' feet field with giant wooden spools strategically spaced out and 8' sheets of plywood bunkers creating X's to hide in. The flag is in the center of this fast field - and is, without a doubt, one of our player's favorite fields.</p> |



CROSSWALK STANDARDS AGREEMENT

Dear Parents and Campers:

Thank you in advance for allowing your child to participate in this weekend. We are looking forward to getting to know each of them. Our desire is to provide positive role models and provide an opportunity for them to develop a closer walk with Jesus Christ. We are very excited about *CROSSWALK 2010 - SPRING CAMP*. It is a weekend, which has been built on many months of prayer. We feel the most important part of this camp, is a deep surrender through prayer and Bible study. The staff, counselors, parents and congregations throughout the region, has been seeking God's face and His will for this special gathering. It is our hope that all that is said and done will be to the glory and honor of our Lord and Savior.

We would ask that your son or daughter **not** bring the following items:

1. Any kind of weapon (including knives, lighters, water guns, etc)
2. No alcohol, cigarettes or any kind of illegal drugs
3. No food or beverages (due to pests and insects)
4. No unnecessary valuable items (including excess cash)
5. No electronic equipment (including tape players, CD players, radios, MP3 players or Video games.) *Inexpensive cameras and alarm clocks are allowed.*

There is another area we would like to address, and that is in the area of appropriate 'Godly' attire. Even though we strongly feel a person's heart is what matters most to God - the way we act and the way we dress, can reflect our relationship and walk with Him. Our clothing can even have an effect on those around us. Please talk to your son or daughter about appropriate attire before they come to camp. Examples of inappropriate attire: bare midriffs, two piece bathing suits, or any other provocative clothing, clothing which contains inappropriate words, symbols or pictures. Everything we do (including the way we dress) should be done to glorify Him.

The Crosswalk Senior Camper Registration form signature area includes spaces for you and your child to "initial" indicating agreement to the Crosswalk standards, Photo/Video Release, and Sexual Purity Presentation. Your child will be officially registered, when we've received the Registration Form - signed and initialed by both of you, Medical Release Form, and recent photo, along with proper payment. Please also remember any additional forms for Paintball, Climbing Wall, etc.

SEXUAL PURITY PERMISSION AGREEMENT

Dear Parents:

I wanted to share something with you, which we feel God has placed on our hearts here at CROSSWALK. As a pastor, District Youth Coordinator and Camp Director, my wife and I have been blessed with the opportunity to work with hundreds of young people over recent years. We have spent thousands of hours counseling these teens and young adults in various aspects of their lives. There are so many pressures they face daily. We have found the number one area they struggle with, almost without exception, is in the area of Sexual Purity. More than even drugs and alcohol combined, there is a severe misperception among our young people of what it means to remain sexually pure as a child of God.

We have spent many hours here at CROSSWALK, praying for God to show us what His heart is and how we can reach young people for His Kingdom. We feel it is very important to convey through the use of scripture and experience, what God would have them do, in regard to sexual purity.

Some parents may be nervous about their child being exposed to talks about Purity. As a father of two teen boys, I understand, but let me say this - our children are already being exposed to Satan's sexual standards via television, movies, music and especially by their peers at school. They are being exposed far earlier than we as parents may realize. It seems there are too few people in our world who are standing up against Satan and standing up for our children and for God.

We have prayerfully put together two Breakout Sessions, one for the girls and one for the boys, ages 12 and up. In these sessions, we will carefully and lovingly discuss what God's will is and why He wants us to wait until we get married to share the gift of sex. We want these sessions to be totally voluntarily, because we find the young people respond much better when they have made the decision to attend on their own. However, we wanted to bring this before you as their parents for two main reasons; 1) so you will be in the CROSSWALK loop and 2) to seek your permission for them to attend. You may do this by initialing the "Sexual Purity Agreement area on the Crosswalk Registration Form.

I thank you for your time and for your support for God's youth. God is doing a powerful work among our young people and it is a privilege and an honor to be a part of it.
